October 2021 AEA Convention Will be Virtual Thursday, October 21, 2021 Obtain 1.5 CEUs for \$50 registration fee!

The American Electrology Association has announced plans for the October 2021 annual convention. Organizations are facing a dilemma when trying to book meetings, conferences and conventions.

During the Covid pandemic, organizations were not able to meet in person and so there is a lot of pent-up demand for meeting spaces as the pandemic abates. Hotels and conference centers have greatly increased their prices for use of their facilities. In some cases, they have doubled their prices. That's a problem for smaller, less well funded organizations. That is what happened to AEA. Officers talked to a hotel about the October meeting and thought they had things worked out. Before they received the contract for signing, they received a call that the hotel had raised its prices substantially for guest rooms and meeting spaces.

The conference will be online this year. Sadly, we won't get to hang out with other electrologists, but we still have the opportunity to earn 1.5 CEUs for \$50. The seminars will all be online.
